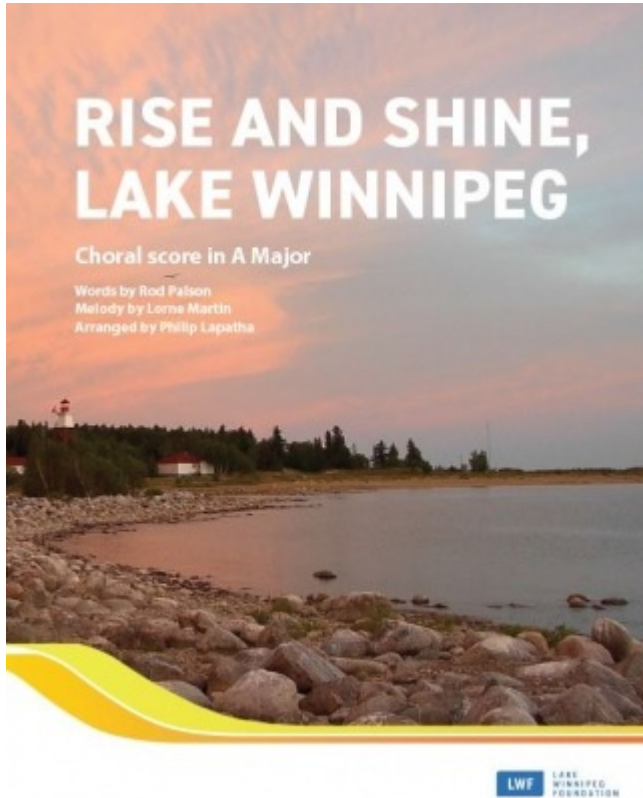
## New Lake Winnipeg resource for music educators
